on your regular service day.

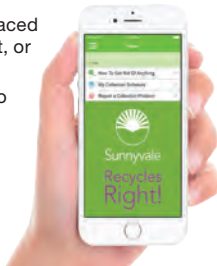


Got Food Scraps?

You'll likely have extra food scraps around the holidays that you can place in the yellow side of your FoodCycle cart:

- trimmings from food prep
- plate scrapings
- turkey carcass and bones
- spoiled leftovers

- Cooking oil — let it cool completely, then pour into either:
 - A clear plastic bag, then placed in the food side of your cart, or
 - A clear plastic jug with a screw-top lid placed next to your cart on collection day.
